ESSENTIAL FIRE SAFETY CHECKLIST FOR YOUR BUSINESS

The Farmington Fire Department would like to bring to your attention some of the fire and life Safety requirements you may need to comply with for occupancy of your new or existing business. To avoid delays in the approval of your business license, we have provided this compliance list and tips.

- **If renovations are being done, let the fire department and city building official know prior to starting. This will ensure renovations meet the codes and save you from having to redo work.**
- **Once you are ready to open for business, call the fire department and city building official for your business license inspection. We will not give approval to spaces that are not complete.**
- **Allow time between the inspection and your planned opening. This gives you time to correct any issues found and schedule a follow up inspection.**

1. Fire extinguishers shall be installed as follows:
 - (a) One (5lb) extinguisher, classification of 2A10BC minimum, for every 75ft.
 - (b) Extinguisher(s) shall be located in a conspicuous location where they will be readily accessible, mounted upright between 36-60 inches above floor at the point(s) of egress.
 - (c) Serviced annually with current service tag attached. Fire extinguishers from a home improvement store are not tagged and do not meet the code.
2. Fire protection systems shall have current service identification as follows:
 - (a) Sprinkler systems inspected every year.
 - (b) Hood and duct systems for cooking equipment cleaned serviced per fire code.
3. Exit signs and emergency lighting must be in working order.
4. Exits and exit discharges shall be continuously maintained and free from obstructions.
5. If you have a door with a locking mechanism and there should be a conditional sign stating the door must remain unlocked when the business is occupied.
6. Extension cords and flexible cords shall not be used as a substitute for permanent wiring. Multi-plug adapters, such as surge protectors, must comply with the Electrical Code.
7. Storage may not come within 18 inches of any sprinkler head or within 24 inches of the ceiling in un-sprinklered buildings.
8. No storage within 36 inches of water heaters, heaters, or electrical panels. No curtains or coverings over an electrical panel are allowed.
9. No open penetrations in the walls or ceilings.
10. Other codes and regulations may be applicable.
