Training Requirement:

For municipalities, Act 671 of 2025 (amending A.C.A. § 14-59-115) requires the primary financial officer (whether elected or appointed) to complete an eight-hour training course. This applies to anyone in charge of financial policies, procedures, accounting, or audit preparation. I completed this training a few weeks ago and Kelly Penn has also completed it.

A Planning Commission work session is scheduled for Monday, August 17, 2026. The regular Planning Commission meeting will be held on Monday, August 24, 2026.

Trail Project:

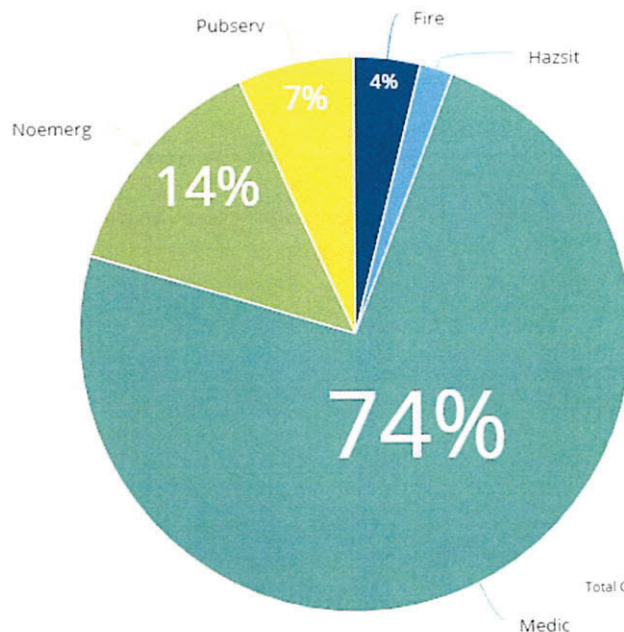

Primary Incident Type by Category



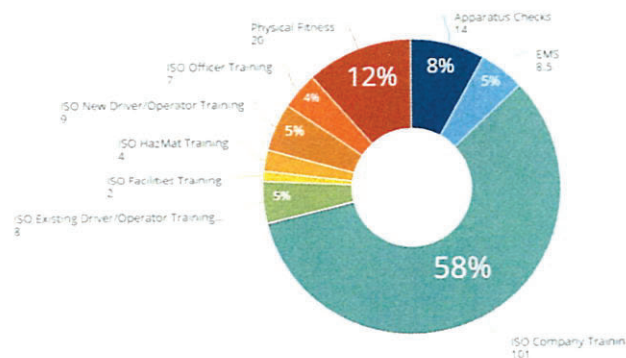
