We would like to recognize all employees this month! We appreciate all our employees—especially during the onset of extreme heat and humidity, for their hard work and commitment to keeping our community safe and well-maintained.

Training Requirement:

For municipalities, Act 671 of 2025 (amending A.C.A. § 14-59-115) requires the primary financial officer (whether elected or appointed) to complete an eight-hour training course. This applies to anyone in charge of financial policies, procedures, accounting, or audit preparation. I completed this training a few weeks ago.

Planning Commission Meetings:

A Planning Commission work session is scheduled for Monday, July 20, 2026. The regular Planning Commission meeting will be held on Monday, July 27, 2026.

Trail Project:

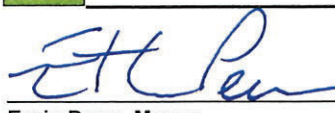
